RESOLUTION NO. 87-35

ACCEPTANCE OF A U. S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY GRANT TO FUND A TOXICITY
REDUCTION PROGRAM IN THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY/DELTA SYSTEM

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) is applying to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 9 (EPA) for a grant under Section 104(b)(3) of the Clean Water Act in the amount of \$350,000 for a two-year toxicity reduction program in the San Francisco Bay/Delta system.
2. This Section 104 grant for water quality investigations will assist the Regional Water Quality Control Boards, Central Valley Region and the San Francisco Bay Region to establish a program for reducing the toxic load to the San Francisco Bay/Delta system.
3. In order to receive the federal funds, the State Board will enter into a signed State/EPA agreement defining the program goals and outputs as detailed in a workplan.
4. A workplan has been prepared which describes the tasks required to evaluate, select, and implement a program for toxicity reduction in the San Francisco Bay/Delta system.
5. Approval to apply for the grant has been requested from the Governor's office.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board approves the 104 Grant application provided the Governor's approval is received.
2. That the State Board authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to accept a Section 104(b)(3) Grant in the amount not to exceed \$350,000 to assist in toxicity reduction in the San Francisco Bay/Delta system.
