

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 87-64

AUTHORIZING THE DISTRIBUTION OF FY 1986-87 GROUND WATER MODELING FUNDS TO REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARDS (REGIONAL BOARDS), AND AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AGREEMENTS OR CONTRACTS TO DO THE GROUND WATER MODELING WORK IN FY 1986-87, FY 1987-88, AND FY 1988-89

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) is the lead agency for planning and other activities to protect ground water quality for sustained beneficial use.
2. Models of ground water basins are an effective tool to assist the State and Regional Boards with their responsibilities to protect ground water quality.
3. The FY 1986-87 Budget provides \$300,000 for ground water modeling.
4. The North Coast, Central Coast, Colorado River Basin, and Santa Ana Regional Boards have particular ground water modeling applications that are appropriate uses of these funding resources.
5. There is insufficient State and Regional Board staff and expertise available to perform the necessary work within the estimated time frame.
6. The State Board is permitted to contract for the performance of this work.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:


1. That the State Board authorizes the distribution of FY 1986-87 budgeted ground water modeling funds to the Regional Boards as follows:

North Coast Regional Board	\$40,000
Central Coast Regional Board	\$90,000
Colorado River Basin Regional Board	\$110,000
Santa Ana Regional Board	\$60,000

2. That the State Board authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute or amend agreements or contracts for the identified Regional Boards to do the ground water modeling work for an accumulative amount not to exceed \$300,000.
3. The Executive Director shall condition the contract for the Coachella Valley Ground Water Modeling Study so that such contracts shall be inoperative without matching federal participation.
