

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 89-38

REQUESTING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A GRANT AND ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) TO ACCELERATE SOURCE INVESTIGATION ACTIVITIES IN THE SAN GABRIEL VALLEY.

WHEREAS:


1. The San Gabriel Valley Ground Water Basin provides drinking water for over one million people.
2. A portion of the San Gabriel Valley Ground Water Basin is polluted with volatile organic compounds at levels exceeding State and federal health standards.
3. The San Gabriel Valley Ground Water Basin was placed on EPA's National Priorities List (Superfund) in 1984.
4. The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) has been investigating sources of ground water pollution in the San Gabriel Valley since October 1985 in an attempt to identify potential responsible parties.
5. At its October 20, 1988 meeting, the State Board adopted Resolution No. 88-115 directing the Executive Director to apply for and accept a grant for a Cooperative Agreement with EPA to accelerate source investigation activities.
6. In October 1988, the Executive Director applied for a grant and indicated an intent to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with EPA. A Cooperative Agreement was executed on March 30, 1989.
7. EPA is making a grant, which will fund additional staff positions to accelerate source identification activities in San Gabriel Valley, available to the State and Regional Board.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Executive Director or his designee is directed to apply for and accept a grant and enter into a Cooperative Agreement with EPA to accelerate source investigation activities in the San Gabriel Valley.
