

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 90-6

APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL
PLAN FOR THE SANTA ANA BASIN REVISING BENEFICIAL USES OF
THE WATERBODIES OF THE BASIN

WHEREAS:

1. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region (Santa Ana Regional Board) adopted the amended Water Quality Control Plan for the Santa Ana Basin (Basin Plan) in November 1983;
2. Section 13240 of the California Water Code specifies that basin plans be periodically reviewed and, if appropriate, revised;
3. On July 14, 1989 following a public hearing, the Santa Ana Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 89-99 (Attachment 1) which amended the Basin Plan by revising the Table of Beneficial Uses;
4. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board), after reviewing the Basin Plan amendment and supporting documents provided by the Santa Ana Regional Board and other available information, finds that the Basin Plan amendment is consistent with the requirements of the Clean Water Act, as amended;
5. Sections 13245 and 13246 of the California Water Code specify that Basin Plan amendments, adopted by a Regional Board, do not become effective until approved by the State Board;
6. The Santa Ana Regional Board Resolution No. 89-99 was adopted in accordance with State laws and regulations.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves the Basin Plan amendments adopted by the Santa Ana Regional Board in Resolution No. 89-99 and directs staff to submit the amendments to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
