

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD  
RESOLUTION NO. 90-35

APPROVAL OF THE FFY 1990 FEDERAL CAPITALIZATION GRANT  
AND AMENDMENT OF THE FFY 1990 INTENDED USE PLAN (IUP)

WHEREAS:


1. The State Board desires to continue the State Revolving Fund (SRF) Loan Program;
2. Section 601 of the Clean Water Act authorizes the Administrator of EPA to make Capitalization Grants to the state for the purpose of establishing a Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund for providing assistance (1) for construction of publicly-owned treatment works, (2) for implementing a management program under Section 319, and (3) for developing and implementing a conservation and management plan under Section 320;
3. The State Board has approved the FFY 1990 Clean Water Loan Priority List, the FFY 1990 IUP, and the Operating Agreement for submittal to EPA as part of the Capitalization Grant Application process; and
4. The 1990 IUP should be amended to reflect the approved FFY 1990 appropriation and the Division of Water Quality's request to use the maximum amount of Title II monies for grants to correct nonpoint source pollution.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Approves the amended FFY 1990 IUP with \$13.7 million in Title II grant funds reserved for nonpoint source projects.
2. Authorizes the Executive Officer to apply for, accept, and sign the FFY 1990 Capitalization Grant.
