RESOLUTION NO. 90-89

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN FOR THE
SANTA ANA WATERSHED PROJECT (SAWPA) RAPID INFILTRATION
EXTRACTION (RIX) DEMONSTRATION FOR THE CITIES OF
COLTON AND SAN BERNARDINO

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities";
2. The State Board, on September 6, 1989, adopted the FFY 1990 SRF Loan Program Priority List;
3. The State Board, on September 6, 1989, approved the FFY 1990 SRF Intended Use Plan;
4. The proposed loan is consistent with the Board's FFY 1990 Intended Use Plan;
5. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report and environmental documents for the RIX Demonstration project;
6. The State Board has determined that land used for infiltration basins is an integral part of the RIX treatment process; and
7. The Division of Clean Water Programs has reviewed and considered the information contained in the Environmental Impact Report and Negative Declaration prepared for the project (State Clearinghouse Nos. 87070605 and 90020389 respectively), and has determined that the benefits of the project outweigh the unavoidable adverse impact and that sufficient mitigation measures have been incorporated into the proposed project to reduce all other potential impacts to less than significant levels.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Waive its SRF policy which provides that SRF funds will not be used to fund land purchase.
2. Approve SRF loan funding only for land which is needed for the demonstration project and which is an integral part of the RIX treatment process.
3. Allow SRF loan funding to be provided only for land which is needed for a full scale project and which will be an integral part of the RIX treatment process if an SRF loan for the full scale project is approved.

4. Approve SRF loan of \$6.22 million for the SAWPA RIX demonstration project, Project No. 4100-110, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first repayment to be due one (1) year after completion of construction.
