

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 91-24

APPROVAL OF TWO STATE REVOLVING LOANS TO
THE BROADVIEW WATER DISTRICT AND
THE PANOCHÉ DRAINAGE DISTRICT

WHEREAS:

1. The Broadview Water District has requested a \$1,500,000 loan and the Panoche Drainage District has requested a \$450,000 loan from the State Revolving Fund (SRF) for Irrigation Improvement Projects.
2. Both districts have completed a notice of exemption from CEQA requirements.
3. The projects are consistent with Central Valley Regional Board Resolution No. 88-195, approved by the State Board in Resolution No. 89-88, as a best management practice for reducing agricultural subsurface drainage through water conservation.
4. The projects are in accordance with "The San Joaquin Valley Drainage Program" final report as a method for source control to manage subsurface drainage in the San Joaquin Valley.
5. In addition to reducing Selenium and salt loading to the San Joaquin River from agricultural subsurface drainage, the projects will promote irrigation efficiency, improved management and water conservation practices.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Broadview Water District and the Panoche Drainage District Irrigation Improvement Projects are categorically exempt from CEQA requirements.
2. That the Intended Use Plan is amended to include the Broadview Water District and the Panoche Drainage District Irrigation Improvement Projects.
3. That the Nonpoint Source Management Plan is amended to include the Broadview Water District and Panoche Drainage District Irrigation Improvement Projects.
4. That the SRF Priority List is amended to include the Broadview Water District and Panoche Drainage District Irrigation Improvement Projects.
5. That SRF loans of \$1,500,000 and \$450,000 are approved for Broadview Water District and Panoche Drainage District.

6. That the repayment period for Broadview Water District is 5 years, and for Panoche Drainage District 10 years after first disbursement.
