## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 91-37

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES (DHS) FOR LABORATORY ANALYTICAL SERVICES FOR THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARDS (REGIONAL BOARDS) IN FISCAL YEAR (FY) 1991-92

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The Regional Boards have a continuing need for laboratory analyses of water quality samples taken as part of their regulatory programs.
- 2. The Regional Boards' use of water quality sampling and analysis is an important part of the State Water Resources Control Board's regulatory program.
- 3. The DHS, which has provided such services since 1976, is capable of and amenable to providing such services in FY 1991-92.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute an interagency agreement with the DHS for an amount not to exceed \$242,290 in FY 1991-92 General Fund monies for Regional Board laboratory analytical services through June 30, 1992, subject to availability of funds.
