RESOLUTION NO. 91-104

APPROVAL OF A REQUEST TO USE UP TO \$200,000 FROM THE
UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CLEANUP FUND (SB 2004)

WHEREAS:


1. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region, (Regional Board) has requested an amount not to exceed \$200,000 from the Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund for the emergency cleanup of underground storage tanks that are causing a nuisance and threaten to pollute the Eel River;
2. Prompt action by the Regional Board to abate the situation is necessary to protect human health and the environment;
3. It appears that there is no responsible party with the financial resources to complete the cleanup work; and
4. Funds for this type of emergency cleanup project under SB 2004 (Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund Program) are available, if the State Board authorizes their use.
5. The Regional Board issued an order on August 12, 1991 to Judith Astier, Roger Astier, Gary Clay and Brian Foyster, that the date for compliance with that order has expired and those named in the order have failed to comply with that order.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Pursuant to Sections 25299.36 and 25299.37 of the Health and Safety Code, authorizes an amount not to exceed \$200,000 from the Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund (SB 2004) to be paid to the Regional Board, to be used for emergency cleanup work for leaking underground tanks at 255 Wildwood Avenue in the town of Rio Dell; and
2. Requests the Attorney General to pursue appropriate legal action against any and all responsible parties.
