STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 93-39

AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE MAXIMUM HOURLY CHARGE ALLOWABLE IN THE LOCAL OVERSIGHT PROGRAM (LOP), IN THE UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK (UST) PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

1. Leaking UST sites require cleanup to protect drinking water supplies and other beneficial uses of ground and surface waters.

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- The State Water Resources Control Board's policy on USTs encourages local agencies to play a strong role in supervising the investigation and cleanup of leaking USTs.
- 3. The Local Oversight Program has been established to provide funds to local agencies for the oversight of investigation and cleanup at leaking UST sites.
- 4. Assembly Bill 3560, <u>Statutes of 1990</u>, directs the State Water Board to adjust the maximum site-specific hourly charge paid to LOP agencies based on the National Deflator Index. Using the Index, the applicable rate for Fiscal Year 1993-94 is \$125 per hour. The appropriate State and Regional Water Board rate is \$38 per hour.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board authorizes staff to increase the maximum site-specific hourly rate paid to Local Oversight Program agencies to \$125 per hour for the Fiscal Year 1993-94 contract and State and Regional Water Boards rate to \$38 and adjust the rate annually based on the National Deflator Index.
