STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 93-48

AUTHORIZATION TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT A FINAL APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF THE CALIFORNIA UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK (UST) PROGRAM AND NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (USEPA)

WHEREAS:

- The 1984 Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act establishes a federal UST regulatory program which provides a procedure by which states may administer and enforce state UST programs in lieu of the federal program;
- 2. The Legislature has declared that it is in the interest of the people of the State to implement the federal program, and has designated the State Water Board as lead agency for all purposes stated in the federal UST law;
- 3. Federal procedures call for the submittal to the USEPA of a formal State program application consisting of standard components, including an MOA which specifies USEPA and State responsibilities under the approved UST program;
- 4. To achieve the Legislative directive, the State Water Board must prepare and submit such application.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to (1) prepare and submit to the USEPA a final application for approval of the California UST program and (2) negotiate and execute an MOA regarding roles and responsibilities of USEPA and the State Water Board under the approved UST program.
