STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 93-58

AUTHORIZATION TO AMEND THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO

WHEREAS:

- The State Budget Act of 1984, as amended by AB 3544, appropriated \$5,365,000 for local assistance to plan, design and construct a treatment facility to handle untreated sewage entering the United States from Tijuana, Mexico;
- The City of San Diego and the State Water Resources Control Board have entered into a contract for the City to participate in the planning, design and construction of facilities for treatment of wastewater flowing into the United States from Tijuana, Mexico.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

That the State Water Resources Control Board Executive Director be authorized to amend the contract with the City of San Diego to extend the time for completion to December 31, 1998 for the San Diego/Tijuana Border water quality problem and to allow for advance payments for approved tasks.
