## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 93-84

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A GRANT AMENDMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY REGARDING STATE OVERSIGHT AT THE LAWRENCE LIVERMORE NATIONAL LABORATORY SITE 300 FACILITY

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The United States Department of Energy (DOE) has established an Environmental Restoration and Waste Management Five-Year Plan to bring all of its facilities into compliance with the letter and spirit of state and federal environmental laws, regulations, and requirements.
- 2. Communication and coordination with State agencies is critical to DOE's success in this endeavor.
- 3. DOE and the State of California have negotiated a Federal Facilities Agreement which authorizes funding for State oversight activities at DOE's LLNL Site 300 Facility.
- 4. During the last two years, the Regional Water Board has provided assistance in implementing the program by performing water quality oversight of DOE environmental restoration and compliance activities.
- 5. DOE will provide financial resources to the State and Regional Water Boards for approximately \$119,000 for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 1994.
- 6. A Grant Amendment between the State Water Board and DOE has been drafted which provides FFY 1994 funds to the State and Regional Boards and represents a commitment by the Regional Water Board to conduct oversight of DOE environmental restoration and compliance activities at LLNL's Site 300 on a timely, constructive, and fiscally sound basis.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to execute a Grant Amendment in the amount of \$119,000 for the period October 1, 1993 to September 31, 1994 with the Department of Energy regarding State oversight at LLNL's Site 300 facility.
