STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2013-0012

AMEND THE POLICY FOR IMPLEMENTING THE CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND (CWSRF)

WHEREAS:

- The Division of Financial Assistance (Division) administers the CWSRF Program to provide low-cost financing for publicly owned treatment works, including wastewater treatment facilities, sanitary sewer collection systems, sewer interceptors, and water reclamation facilities, implementation of programs and projects to control pollution from nonpoint sources and storm water drainage, and development and implementation of estuary cleanup programs;
- The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) originally adopted the Policy for Implementing the Clean Water State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities (CWSRF Policy) on August 18, 1988, and has amended it periodically;
- 3. The State Water Board adopted the *Strategy for Implementing State Revolving Fund for Expanded-Use Projects (Strategy);*
- 4. The Strategy has been consolidated into the CWSRF Policy; and
- 5. Interested parties were notified by email and a public notice was posted on the State Water Board's website on March 22, 2013, of their opportunity to comment on these actions; comments were due at noon on April 24, 2013.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The State Water Board amends the CWSRF Policy as shown in revised Exhibit A; and
- 2. The State Water Board rescinds the Strategy.
