## STATE OF CALIFORNIA STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD

In the Matter of the Petition of American Canyon County Water District for Review of Order No. 71-69 of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region

Order 72-1

On November 26, 1971, the American Canyon County Water District petitioned the State Water Resources Control Board to review Order No. 71-69 of the San Francisco Bay regional water quality control board adopted on October 28, 1971, requiring American Canyon County Water District to cease and desist from discharging waste in violation of requirements prescribed by the regional board.

In addition to ordering the district to cease and desist from violations of requirements, the order also stated that the regional board would review the order at its April 1972 meeting to consider whether a prohibition of discharges to the sewerage system would be necessary to prevent further unreasonable impairment of water quality.

Subsequent to the filing of the petition the regional board informed the district that no further action regarding a prohibition of discharge to the sewerage system of the district would be taken without further notice and hearing. Counsel for the district has informed the State Board that in view of this information the petition has become moot and may be dismissed.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition of the American Canyon County Water District be, and it is, dismissed.
