In the Matter of City of Tracy --Petition for Review of Action of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region

Order No. 72-8

On April 23, 1971 the City of Tracy petitioned the State Water Resources Control Board to review the action of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, of March 26, 1971 adopting Order No. 71-214 prescribing waste discharge requirements for the city.

The City of Tracy requested the State Board to modify or delete certain requirements contained in Order No. 71-214. On July 16, 1971 the City of Tracy filed a new report of waste discharge, materially changing the location of the discharge from Sugar Cut Canal to Old River. On February 25, 1971 the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, adopted waste discharge requirements on the new discharge location and rescinded Order No. 71-214.

The adoption of waste discharge requirements for the new discharge location and rescission of Order No. 71-214 on which the City of Tracy requested review makes the need for further review by the State Board moot.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition by the City of Tracy on Order No. 71-214 of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, is dismissed.
