
- Cause and effect
- Delta smelt response to past or future actions


What We Think We Know

- No apparent major link to toxicity
- Decline has accompanied increases and changes in timing of project diversions
- Existing invasive species are a key factor
- Major flow paths

State Water Board Actions Past And On-going

- Pesticide control programs (TMDLs)
- Limits on point source discharges
- Bay-Delta water quality control planning

Past And On-going Actions Pesticide Control Programs (TMDLs)

- Sacramento River, San Joaquin River and Delta TMDLs
- Irrigated Lands Program
- Protect aquatic life from pesticide runoff
- On-going monitoring to identify problem areas

Past And On-going Actions Limits On Point Source Discharges

- More stringent standards over last decade
- Consider toxicity, dissolved oxygen, endangered species
- Major upgrades: tertiary filtration, nitrification
- WWTPs: Lodi, Stockton, Manteca, Tracy, Mountain House

Past And On-going Actions Bay-Delta Water Quality Control Planning

- Updated Water Quality Control Plan:
 - Adopted December 2006
 - OAL approval July 2007
- Emerging Issues: POD, climate change, salinity, San Joaquin River flows

State Water Board Actions Current

- Rapid response to and evaluation of pesticide toxicity and salmon mortality
- Immediate response and approval of a temporary urgency change petition
- Delta smelt refuge
- Letter to Delta water right holders

Current Actions Evaluation Of Pesticide Toxicity And Salmon Mortality

- Pesticide toxicity:
 - Review UCD samples
 - POD contaminants work team
 - Synthesis of many programs
 - widespread water column toxicity from pyrethroids unlikely

Current Actions Temporary Urgency Change Petition


- June 8 Merced Irrigation District request
- Provide additional San Joaquin River flow:
 - 15,000 acre-feet at 850 cfs
- Helped to maintain net positive flow on Old and Middle Rivers
- Approved June 8

Current Actions Delta Smelt Refuge

- Fish Conservation and Culture Lab (FCCL) at Byron
- FCCL has 1000 wild delta smelt
- No new wild smelt can be caught
- UCD, FWS, and DWR joint refuge proposal by August 8: startup funds needed by Fall

Current Actions Letter to Delta water right holders

- Request for information to approximately 600 water right holders:
 - Diversion amount
 - Changes in response to DFG letter?
 - Screened?
 - Measuring device?




Screened Versus Unscreened












Screened Versus Unscreened Legend Screened Diversions **Unscreened Diversions** Legal Delta Boundary 18


















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
