SUBJECT

INFORMATION ITEM ON THE DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY-PROGRAM STATUS AND UPDATE.

DISCUSSION

The Division of Water Quality assists the State Water Resources Control Board in the administration of its statewide water quality program. Many statewide water quality issues and actions come before the State Water Board as information or action items. Other water quality actions are delegated to either the Executive Director or the Deputy Director for Water Quality. The purpose of this item is to update State Water Board members and others on the status of delegated activities including enrollment in statewide orders adopted by the State Water Board; ongoing monitoring efforts regarding groundwater; site clean-up activities; information management systems; federal grants, including workload commitments upon which those grants are conditioned; ongoing information management activities; and recent program management efforts including development of a draft three year Division program plan containing proposed program goals and performance measures. Division staff will also provide a brief summary of continuing efforts to conduct reviews pursuant to the Lean Six Sigma process being implemented by the Governor's Office of Business and Economic Development.
