I, as a San Juan Water District customer, have worked very hard to achieve the conservation marks and percentages mandated to date.

I am opposed to having the 33 percent conservation requirement considered in early February. Due to recent winter weather storms resulting in rising reservoir and lake levels locally, plus today's report that the Sierra snowpack is 115% percent of normal and at the highest level in five years, I believe conservation requirements should be reevaluated in April when the water supply conditions are better known, after the April 1 snowpack measurement and when most of the rains and snows of the winter season will have already occurred.
