I am a customer that resides in the San Juan Water District (SJWD) service area and have been following the Board's actions since the Governor's Emergency Drought declaration last year. I think the Board acted appropriately and fairly in determining conservation tiers throughout the State even though as a San Juan customer our conservation was in the highest tier. I also feel the SJWD has done a very good job in informing and working with customers to help them meet their conservation goals during this historic drought.

I understand that CA reservoirs are still below historical averages and in many cases below where they were at this time last year. However as the snow pack conditions are vastly different and the universally forecasted El Nino storms continue to line up, I agree with the SJWD that it is premature for the SWRCB to consider extending the existing emergency conservation regulations in early February. Therefore I request that conservation requirements for 2016 be reevaluated in April after we all have a better feel for the water storage situation going into the 2016 season.
