### NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

#### PROPOSED APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE SANTA ANA REGION TO REVISE AND UPDATE THE TOTAL DISSOLVED SOLIDS AND NITROGEN MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (TDS/N MANAGEMENT PROGRAM)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will accept comments on the proposed approval of the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board's (Santa Ana Water Board) amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan for the Santa Ana River Basin that would revise and update the Total Dissolved Solids (TDS) and nitrogen management program (TDS/N management program) in the Santa Ana Region. Specifically, the amendment would update the TDS and Total Inorganic Nitrogen (TIN) Wasteload Allocations for wastewater treatment plants that discharge to the Santa Ana Water River and its Tributaries, and to revise the regional groundwater and surface water monitoring programs associated with the TDS/N Management Program. The Basin Plan amendment was adopted by the Santa Ana Water Board on December 10, 2021 (Resolution R8-2021-0025), and is available for review at the Santa Ana Water Board website at:

**REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMITTING COMMENTS** (23 Cal. Code Regs., § 3779, subd. (f)). The State Water Board may refuse to accept any comments that do not satisfy all of the following requirements:

1. Comments must specifically address the final version of the Basin Plan amendment adopted by the Santa Ana Water Board.
2. If the Santa Ana Water Board previously responded to a similar or identical comment, the commenter must explain why and in what manner the commenter believes each of the responses provided by the Santa Ana Water Board to each comment was inadequate or incorrect.
3. The commenter also must include either a statement that each of the comments was timely raised before the Santa Ana Water Board, or an explanation of why the commenter was unable to raise the specific comment before the Santa Ana Water Board.
