NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE LOS ANGELES REGION (BASIN PLAN) TO REVISE THE TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD FOR TOXIC POLLUTANTS IN DOMINGUEZ CHANNEL AND GREATER LOS ANGELES AND LONG BEACH HARBOR WATERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will consider adopting a resolution approving the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board's (Los Angeles Water Board) amendment to the Basin Plan to revise the Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) for Toxic Pollutants in Dominguez Channel and Greater Los Angeles and Long Beach Harbor Waters (Basin Plan amendment).
