### **BACKGROUND**

The CWSRF IUP outlines the State Water Board's business plan for administering the CWSRF and its complementary funding for the state fiscal year. The IUP specifically identifies the available funding, the types of projects eligible for financing, the criteria for selecting projects, a fundable list of projects, the associated financing terms, certain technical assistance funding, the financial status of the program, and the measures that will be used to track the program's performance.

The CWSRF program provides low-cost financing statewide for wastewater treatment and recycling, non-point source, estuary, storm water, and combined sewer system projects. The Small Community Wastewater (SCWW) Program funding complements the CWSRF program, providing grants through various sources to small disadvantaged communities (DACs) and small severely disadvantaged communities (SDACs) for wastewater projects.

The CWSRF and Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Supplemental IUP for emerging contaminants funding appropriated through the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) will be released with the DWSRF IUP for public comments in the subsequent weeks.

The IUP is required by federal statutes and regulations and will be included in the application submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for the FFY 2025 Capitalization Grant. The IUP also serves as a guideline for SCWW Funding, which includes funding provided by the Budget Acts 2024 and 2025; Proposition 1, the Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act of 2014; Proposition 68, the California Drought, Water, Parks, Climate, Coastal Protection, and Outdoor Access for all Act of 2018; and Proposition 4, the Safe Drinking Water, Wildfire Prevention, Drought Preparedness, and Clean Air Bond Act of 2024.
