BACKGROUND

The State Water Board adopted the Cross-Connection Control Policy Handbook on December 19, 2023, with an effective date of July 1, 2024. The Division of Drinking Water (DDW) is proposing changes to the CCCPH to extend certain compliance dates, correct minor errors and increase clarity.

When submitting written comments, please use the subject line "**Cross-Connection Control Policy Handbook**" in your email and/or transmittal letter.

The State Water Board requests, but does not require, that written comments sent by mail be submitted in triplicate.

The State Water Board requests, but does not require, that if reports or articles in excess of 25 pages are submitted in conjunction with the comments, the commenter provide a summary of the report or article and describe the reason for which the report or article is being submitted or is relevant to the draft CCCPH.

All comments, including e-mail or fax transmissions, should include the author's name and U.S. Postal Service mailing address in order for the State Water Board to provide copies of any notices for proposed changes to the regulation text or rulemaking file on which additional comments may be solicited. Please note that under the California Public Records Act (Gov. Code, §7920.000 et seq.), written and oral comments, attachments, and associated contact information (e.g., your address, phone, email, etc.) become part of the public record and can be released to the public upon request.

Due to the limitations of the e-mail system, emails larger than 15 megabytes (MB) may be rejected and will not be delivered and received by the State Water Board. Therefore, emails larger than 15 MB should be submitted under separate emails or via another form of delivery.
