NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION TO ADOPT THE AMENDMENT TO THE POLICY FOR IMPLEMENTING THE DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will consider adopting the proposed amendment to the Policy for Implementing the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF or DWSRF Policy) Program at its regularly scheduled Board meeting, no earlier than:

BACKGROUND

The DWSRF Policy was written to implement the federal Safe Drinking Water Act's DWSRF Program in California. The DWSRF Policy sets forth the requirements to obtain DWSRF and complementary financing in conjunction with the annual DWSRF Intended Use Plans. The Division of Financial Assistance posted a draft amended DWSRF Policy for public comment on October 22, 2024 and accepted written comments on the proposed draft until November 22, 2024. The Board held a workshop for the proposed amendment to the DWSRF Policy on November 6, 2024.

The DWSRF Policy was last amended on December 3, 2019. Since then, demand on the DWSRF Program has greatly increased, and new priority scoring criteria are being proposed by the Division of Financial Assistance to better manage the increased demand. Additional changes are also being proposed to better manage the credit evaluation process and to improve consistency between the DWSRF and Clean Water State Revolving Fund Policies.
