NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will hold the second plenary meeting of the Second Statewide Agricultural Expert Panel (Panel) on Friday, October 31, to develop initial recommendations in response to the <a href="Panel charge questions">Panel charge questions</a>, which ask the Panel to consider the approaches adopted in the State Water Board <a href="Order WQ 2018-0002">Order WQ 2018-0002</a>, In the Matter of Review of Waste Discharge Requirements General Order No. R5-2012-0116 for Growers Within the Eastern San Joaquin River Watershed that are Members of the Third-Party Group (Eastern San Joaquin Petition Order) and State Water Board <a href="Order WQ 2023-0081">Order WQ 2023-0081</a>, In the Matter of Review of General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges from Irrigated Lands Order No. R3-2021-0040 (Central Coast Ag Petition Order).

A quorum of the State Water Board may be present, but no decisions will be made.

#### **Background**

Water quality impacts associated with agriculture are complex and addressing them requires pooling and focusing the knowledge, expertise, and resources of all interested parties, including growers and their representatives, regulatory agencies, environmental advocates, environmental justice communities, and Tribes and Tribal communities. The State Water Board and the regional water quality control boards (collectively, Water Boards) must develop and implement a long-term, sustainable Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program (ILRP) that protects the quality of waters of the state while supporting the viability of agriculture. With the help of our partners, the Water Boards made substantial progress in defining a science-based approach that provides a solid foundation for next steps.

As described on the Expert Panel website, the Water Boards convened a Panel to evaluate the data collected as part of the ILRP and consider the approaches adopted in the Eastern San Joaquin Petition Order and the Central Coast Ag Petition Order. State Water Board contracted with Sacramento State University College of Continuing Education to convene the Panel to provide recommendations for the ILRP. A two-day Panel kick-off meeting was held in August 2025, and the meeting recordings are available for Day 1 (English and Spanish) and Day 2 (English and Spanish). The two-day meeting provided the Panel with an ILRP overview, perspectives from agricultural representatives and non-governmental organizations, presentations on Indigenous land stewardship and food systems, and available data sources from the Water Boards, approved third-party agricultural representatives, and environmental justice organizations.

As noticed on September 8, 2025, the State Water Board hosted a public listening session on October 1, 2025, where members of the public and other interested parties shared input with the Panel members for their consideration of the Panel charge questions. There will be one additional public listening session for public comment to be scheduled between the remaining public Panel Meetings in late 2025 or early 2026. Additionally, two Panel working group meetings are scheduled for October (Monday, October 13th, and Wednesday, October 22nd), and two working group meetings are scheduled in November (Friday, November 14th, and Wednesday, November 19th) to facilitate Panel deliberations on issues relevant to the Panel charge questions and for Panel members to support formulation of their recommendations.

There will be another plenary Panel Meeting in early 2026. It is anticipated that the Panel will develop a report with recommendations to be presented to the State Water Board responding to the Panel charge questions in 2026.
