Notice of Board Meeting and Opportunity to Comment Sustainable Groundwater Management Act Tule Subbasin Groundwater Minimal Impact Exclusion

The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board or Board) will accept public comments on a draft resolution to adopt a minimal impact exclusion for the Tule Subbasin, a probationary subbasin under the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA). Board staff recommends that extractors in the Tule Subbasin who extract no more than 20 acre-feet of groundwater per year and do not extract groundwater from wells located within two miles of the Friant-Kern Canal be excluded from requirements to report and pay fees to the State Water Board under SGMA.

The Board is seeking comments from the public to inform its decision. The deadline to submit written comments is 12:00 noon on March 30, 2026.

The Board may adopt, modify, or reject the proposed resolution at the April 7, 2026 regularly scheduled State Water Board meeting.

Background

The State Water Board designated the Tule Subbasin as probationary under SGMA on September 17, 2024. Pumpers in the Tule Subbasin are required to report their groundwater extractions by May 1, 2026 and pay fees to the Board, except for pumpers who are granted an exclusion from reporting and fees. Pumpers who extract two acre-feet or less per year for domestic purposes only are considered “de minimis” pumpers and do not have to report and pay fees.

Pursuant to Water Code section 10735.2, subdivision (c)(1), the Board may grant reporting and fee exclusions to a class or category of extractions if those extractions are likely to have a minimal impact on basin withdrawals. The Board will consider applying a minimal impact exclusion and the appropriate threshold for such an exclusion in the Tule Subbasin. Board staff recommends that extractors in the Tule Subbasin who extract no more than 20 acre-feet of groundwater per year be excluded from the reporting and fee requirements. This exclusion would not apply to individuals who extract groundwater within two miles of the Friant-Kern Canal, who would still need to report and pay fees to the Board. If the Board adopts the staff recommendation the minimal impact exclusion would exclude approximately 49% of groundwater pumpers who together account for approximately 1% of total water use in the subbasin from the requirement to report and pay fees to the State Water Board.
