Background

On November 5, 2024, Proposition 4 was approved by voters and made available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, approximately \$386 million for grants which fund projects related to water reuse and recycling. In Senate Bill 105 (Reg. Sess. 2025-26), the Legislature appropriated \$150 million of that sum to the State Water Board, as part of the Budget Act of 2025.

The Administrative Procedure Act (APA) requires state agencies to follow certain procedures when adopting any rule of general application which implements or interprets the law, unless an exemption to the APA applies. Guidelines and other policy documents which govern the administration of funding programs are rules of general application which, absent an exemption, must comply with the APA process. While Proposition 4 did not provide an exemption to the APA, section 90135(e) of the Public Resources Code permits the rules and guidelines which govern Proposition 4 funds to be adopted as emergency regulations, as a way of complying with the Administrative Procedures Act. The emergency regulations proposed in this Resolution will be used to administer the Budget Act of 2025 appropriation of Proposition 4 funds in the Water Recycling Funding Program.
