

WAIVER OF HEARING

You may waive your right to a hearing. If you wish to waive your hearing, an authorized person must check and sign the following "Waiver of Hearing" form and return it to the Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Coast Region, 895 Aerovista Place, Suite 101, San Luis Obispo, California 93401, by **April 24, 2004 5:00 P.M.**

If you do not waive your right to a hearing, the Regional Board will be asked to accept the amount proposed in the Complaint. The Regional Board may proceed with the scheduled hearing and consider testimony received from interested persons during the hearing and decide whether to accept the amount of Mandatory Penalty proposed by the Executive Officer or increase the liability. The Regional Board may also decide to continue the matter to a future hearing or refer it to the State Attorney General.
