Dear Jeff Young,


I am extremely disappointed in the political decision that was made to halt the compromise that would have helped Los Osos become unified and to move forward.

I also am very disappointed in the fines being. We voted as a community to move the sewer out of town and now you are going against that ~~democratic process and throwing impossible burdens in the face of our~~ newly elected officials.

The economic impact will be devastating to the community. The proposed sewer does not even accomplish a significant solution to water quality. It does nothing for the saltwater intrusion and it threatens the estuary with spills when large storms come through. In the mean time I hope we can get a project going with our Measure B that allows the people to get the quality control the other CSD apparently did not have.

I hope we can start working together and work out this situation peaceably. Otherwise it will continue to be delayed. It is such a shame our compromise was derailed. Such a shame.
