SUBJECT: Executive Officer’s Report – Attachment A *Phase II Municipal Storm Water Permit; Storm Water Management Plan Adoption Status Update*

SUMMARY

The Executive Officer’s Report contains an attachment that depicts the status of Phase II Municipal Storm Water Management Plan (SWMP) adoption. At the time of the agenda mailing (8/12/05), Attachment A portrayed an accurate depiction of the progress of the SWMP adoption process. Since that time, Water Board staff sent three additional review letters and received one amended SWMP.

The Water Board’s Storm Water Team recently reorganized as a result of the creation of the office’s new Enforcement Unit. Now, each of four staff people are assigned to one program area across the region instead of having four staff people enforcing all aspects of the permit in separate counties.

This reorganization allows Storm Water staff to focus on one program at a time and is in part responsible for recent progress in the SWMP review process.

Ryan Lodge, a former Water Board staff person, has returned to Region 3 and is assigned to the Phase II Municipal program, specifically Attachment 1 and 2 municipalities.

David Innis, currently employed at the Water Board office in Fresno will join the Region 3 Storm Water Team on September 12 and will be responsible for the Construction, Industrial, and Caltrans programs.
