DISCUSSION

Cemex USA, Inc (Discharger) owns the Olympia Sand Plant formerly owned and operated by RMC Pacific Materials, Inc. The plant no longer quarries sand and is shut The plant discharges no process wastewater, which consisted of washwater of WDRs Order No. 00-026 quarried sand. regulates the quality of the occasional discharge of washwater, storm water and spring water to Zayante Creek. Three ponds in series clarified the washwater before its discharge, and continue to settle solids from storm water runoff entering the ponds. NPDES Permit No. 0048739 expired on May 19, 2005.

The County of Santa Cruz is overseeing the site's reclamation in accordance with the federal Surface Mining and Reclamation Act (SMARA). In accordance with SMARA, the Discharger shall restore the site to its former stability by reshaping the land surface and planting native vegetation. Once the site has been reclaimed, it will no longer threaten the

beneficial uses of Zayante Creek. Until the site has been reclaimed, the Discharger shall remain enrolled under the NPDES General Permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Construction Activity. Therefore, the waste discharge requirements in Order No. 00-026 are no longer needed to protect the uses of Zayante Creek.
