**INFORMATION:** The following information and comments were received after preparation of the

agenda staff report.

#### SUMMARY

The City of San Luis Obispo (City) notes that the date of NPDES permit renewal for the Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) is May 2007, not March 2007. Water Board staff agrees.

Also, Water Board staff notes that changes to this facility's current Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) to incorporate nitrate-N monitoring are not necessary because the MRP currently requires nitrate-N monitoring.

Staff proposes the following changes. Deletions have a strike-through and additions are underlined.

### **Proposed Changes**

1. Attachment-A (Resolution)

Page 6, IMPLEMENTATION section, first bullet: "...first permit renewal following TMDL approval by the Central Coast Water Board (expected in March May 2007)."

2. Attachment-A (Resolution)

Page 7, MONITORING section, first bullet "...next permit renewal following TMDL approval by the Central Coast Water Board [expected in March May 2007])."

3. Attachment-B (Project Report)

Page 48, the end of the first paragraph: "...first permit renewal following TMDL approval by the Central Coast Water Board (expected in March May 2007)."

## 4. Staff Report

Page 2, IMPLEMENTATION section, middle of second paragraph, the following language should be deleted: "In the nearer term (at the next permit renewal, anticipated to be March 2006), the Central Coast Water Board Executive Office (EO) or the Board itself intends to amend the monitoring and reporting program associated with this permit to incorporate both effluent and stream monitoring for nitrate-N."
