DISCUSSION

The Central Coast Water Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 91-101 to regulate sanitary wastewater discharges from Hall Ranch Subdivision to an onsite wastewater system. The subdivision consists of 17 residential lots on 319 acres. However, none of the proposed homes or the wastewater facility have been constructed.

The current owner is in the process of selling the property. If a different owner proposed to discharge in the future, the new owner will need new waste discharge requirements or other authorization to discharge.
