OVERVIEW

On May 30, 2024, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Coast Region (Central Coast Water Board) received a letter from the Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians. The letter urges the Central Coast Water Board to adopt beneficial use definitions into the Basin Plan for the following Tribal Beneficial Uses: Tribal Tradition and Culture, Tribal Subsistence Fishing, and Subsistence Fishing. The Central Coast Water Board's Chair accepted the comment letter into the record for Agenda Item 16.

The letter supports the proposed amendments to the Basin Plan.
