8. Public Workshop on the Development of an Alternative Water Supply Program for Residents Relying on Groundwater that Exceeds the Maximum Contaminant Level for Nitrate as a Result of Agricultural Operations

This item included two presentations from Central Coast Water Board staff followed by two 15-minute public commentors and then general public comments on the item. Central Coast Water Board Executive Officer, Ryan Lodge, and Environmental Program Manager, Mary Hamilton, introduced the item.

James Bishop provided the first staff presentation titled Assessment of Interim Drinking Water Needs and Costs in Central Coast Areas Affected by Agricultural Nitrate Groundwater Contamination (Interim Need and Cost Assessment). Staff answered Board Member questions throughout the presentation.

Staff noted that an assessment of costs for long-term drinking water solution would be released in the next year.

Mary Hamilton provided the second staff presentation titled *Conceptual Structure* for the Alternative Water Supply Program (Concepts Presentation).

The Ag Partners provided a 15-minute presentation to share their comments. Norm Groot and Abby Taylor-Silva provided comment on behalf of the Agricultural Partners (with Tess Dunham available for questions on Zoom). Norm Groot and Abby Taylor-Silva answered Board member questions throughout their presentation.

Following the public comment from the Ag Partners, the Environmental Justice Representatives provided 15 minute presentation to provide their comments. Kjia Rivers and Elias Rodriguez spoke on behalf of the Environmental Justice Representatives and engaged with the Board members regarding questions.

State Water Board Division of Water Quality Chief Deputy Director Karen Mogus was present at the meeting and provided a response to the question regarding the ability of SAFER to act as a program administrator, indicating that State Water Board staff are considering this request, but no decisions have been made.

Following the 15-minute comment and presentation from the Environmental Justice Representatives, the Board heard public comments on this item. All commenters are listed below. The Board members engaged with Sarah Lopez from Central Coast Water Quality Preservation Inc. regarding the number of growers who are considered small and/or disadvantaged farmers.
