Project Description:

The purpose of the proposed Project is to protect the section of sewer line that was exposed by erosion during the 2023-2024 rainy season.

The proposed project activities include:

- Removing and excavating woody debris from the exposed trunkline using a mini excavator or skid steer:
- Filling the surrounding area with 170 cubic yards of rock slope protection to support the crossing;
- Re-grading the creek banks that were eroded away adjacent to the trunkline; and
- Backfilling the channel floor to re-establish the grade transition.

Mitigation activities include:

- Permittee responsible re-establishment of 0.01 acres / 20 linear feet of stream channel habitat; and
- Permittee responsible rehabilitation of 0.03 acres / 50 linear feet of stream channel habitat.

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
