### **Project Description:**

The purpose of the project is to improve the safety and structural integrity of Fisherman's Wharf in Monterey.

The proposed project activities include:

- Replacing pile wraps to 21 existing timber piles;
- Constructing three 15-inch diameter concrete piles on 48-inch diameter, 4-foot tall constructed concrete bases;
- Constructing one 5-foot x 11-foot x 5-foot tall concrete base encasement for two 36-inch square damaged existing concrete piles.

No mitigation is proposed.
