### **Project Description:**

The project purpose is to repair a county roadway damaged during the February / March 2023 Atmospheric River.

The proposed project activities include:

- Replacing a failed 48-inch diameter corrugated metal pipe storm drain with a 48-inch diameter double-walled HDPE storm drain;
- Removing two failed concrete crib walls;
- Constructing a 32 foot long by 8-foot high cast in place reinforced inlet headwall;
- Constructing a 23-foot by 17-foot high concrete reinforced outlet crib wall; and
- Armoring inlet and outlet slopes with vegetated rock slope protection.

The proposed mitigation activities include:

- Permittee responsible re-establishment of 0.026 acres / 36 linear feet of riparian habitat; and
- Permittee responsible re-establishment of 0.003 acres / 8 linear feet of stream channel habitat.
