### **Project Description:**

The purpose of the proposed Project is to conduct desilting and vegetation removal operations for flood control purposes. The proposed project activities include:

- Removing sediments, increasing creeks capacity, increasing tidal prism, and replenishing a local beach (Goleta Slough); and
- Discing channel bottom, applying herbicides, desilting channel and stockpiling sediments, and hauling stockpiled sediments (Lower Atascadero Creek).

Proposed mitigation activities include:

- Permittee-responsible restoration and protection of emergent and forested wetlands habitat; and
- Permittee-responsible creation and long-term protection of riparian woodland.
