Project Description:

The purpose of the proposed Project is to improve passage for southern California steelhead through the concrete flood control portion of the San Jose Creek channel and upstream to the natural migration corridor that leads to spawning and rearing habitat in the upper watershed.

The proposed project activities include:

- Removing the existing non-functioning wooden weirs and wedges;
- Fixing and modifying the existing concrete weirs;
- Adding new concrete vortex-type weirs; and
- Re-grading a small reach of the upstream natural channel to restore the original channel gradient.

Impacts will be mitigated on site with the installation of native riparian vegetation along the creek banks within the natural migration corridor at the northern portion of the Project site.
