Project Description:

The purpose of the proposed Project is for the replacement of an existing UPRR bridge over a secondary tidal channel in Elkhorn Slough. The existing 10-foot timber trestle bridge is undersized, restricts tidal connectivity, and provides limited drainage capacity.

The proposed project activities include:

- Creation of a temporary access corridor;
- Placement of crane mats in wetland areas to minimize compaction;
- Removal of existing bridge abutments;
- Installation of a temporary water diversion system;
- Ballast installation within the UPRR right of way for crane stability;
- Installation of two culverts and sandbag diversions; and
- Full removal of temporary materials and site restoration following construction.

Proposed mitigation includes:

- Permittee-responsible re-establishment of 0.03 acres / 470 linear feet of estuary habitat;
 and
- Permittee-responsible re-establishment of 0.04 acres / 175 linear feet of wetlands habitat.
