	Submit Annual Compliance Form (ACF)	March 1	Log onto GeoTracker and click on [EDIT COMPLIANCE INFO] link	Go to ILP website and click on “Annual Compliance Form”
	Pay annual State Water Board permit fees	June 15	https://www.waterboards.ca.gov/make_a_payment/	Go to ILP website and click on “Annual Irrigated Lands Permit Fees”
	Update electronic Notice of Intent (eNOI) after any change to enrollment information	Within 60 Days	Log onto GeoTracker and click on [EDIT OPERATION INFORMATION] and [EDIT RANCH INFO] links	Go to ILP website and click on “Enrollment”
	Develop, implement and maintain a Farm Water Quality Control Plan (Farm Plan)	Ongoing	Keep on farm and submit if requested by Central Coast Water Board	Go to ILP website and click on “Farm Water Quality Control Plan”

	Submit 2024 TNA or INMP Report	March 1	Log onto GeoTracker and click on [SUBMIT TNA REPORT] link	Go to ILP website and click on “Total Nitrogen Applied Report / Irrigation and Nutrient Management Summary Report”
	Groundwater Phase Areas 1 & 2: maintain Irrigation and Nutrient Management Plan (INMP) records	January 1 - December 31	Maintain records in Farm Plan to submit INMP Report in March 2026	Go to ILP Website and click on “Groundwater Quality Monitoring and Reporting”
	Groundwater Phase Area 3 only: maintain Total Nitrogen Applied (TNA) records	January 1 - December 31	Maintain records in Farm Plan to submit a TNA report in March 2026	
	Conduct water sampling for all on-farm domestic wells and the primary irrigation well	March 1 - May 31	Certified laboratory should upload results to GeoTracker	Go to ILP Website and click on “Groundwater Quality Monitoring and Reporting”
	Notify all domestic well users of well sampling results and health risk information	Within 3 business days of receiving results	Notify all domestic well users using the summary template provided in the resource	
	Update eNOI to confirm notifications to all domestic well users	Within 30 days of receiving results	Log onto GeoTracker, click on [EDIT RANCH INFO] link, and update section XI

	All growers complying individually: submit Surface Receiving Water Quality Trends work plan if not yet submitted	Immediately	Send to AgNOI@waterboards.ca.gov
	Conduct surface receiving water monitoring (after work plan is approved by CCWB)	Ongoing (established in work plan)	Maintain records in Farm Plan
	Upload monitoring data electronically to CEDEN (after work plan is approved by CCWB)	Quarterly by January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1	http://www.ceden.org/ceden_submitdata.shtml
	Submit annual report (after work plan is approved by CCWB)	July 1	Send to AgNOI@waterboards.ca.gov
