Re: Cease and Desist Order No. R3-2006-1008

Mr. Thomas:

This is in response to questions posed in a notice dated May 18, 2006, regarding proposed CDSs to be issued against Los Osos/Baywood Park residents.

Our very brief response to each question is as follows:

Q#1: Yes. The "prosecution's" case should be stricken in its entirety.

Q#2: No. Additional materials are not needed.

Q#3: Yes. Additional written materials developed by the designated parties should be made a matter of record.

Q#4: Yes. The Los Osos CSD should be permitted to start its case over as needed.

Q#5: Health and child care issues are not a major concern. Presentation of individual orders and responses should be pre-scheduled to facilitate a more orderly proceeding.

It would seem to us that entering additional materials by the Water Control Board would only serve to further complicate an already confusing situation.

It would appear that the only real possibility for a final resolution of this matter lies within Item 4. The Los Osos CSD (or, in the event of its dissolution, SLO County) must be the moving agency to offer and implement a solution to the problem or issue outlined by the WCB. A representative agency must be the "spokesman" for the community. To attempt to deal with each individual property owner will only lead to more delay and confusion, and will not result in resolution.

The issue must be resolved by installation of a sewer system, by establishment of a sanitation district, or in some other manner carried out by all affected residents and implemented by all individuals at the same time.

As stated in previous submissions, we are not opposed to installation of a sewer system or other appropriate action as long as it is accomplished in a fair and equitable manner.
