**ORDER AMENDING NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY FOR COVERAGE UNDER  
GENERAL ORDER NO. R5- 2020-0048, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
AND CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION OF  
THE WESTERN PLACER COUNTY HABITAT CONSERVATION PLAN  
PROGRAMMATIC GENERAL PERMIT, LEAVELL TEMPORARY WATER LINE  
PROJECT (WDID#5A31CR00534-033A1), PLACER COUNTY**

This Order responds to the 13 March 2025 request for an amendment of the Leavell Temporary Water Line Project (WDID#5A31CR00534-033) Notice of Applicability for coverage under General Order R5-2020-0048, Waste Discharge Requirements and Clean Water Act Section 401 Water Quality Certification of the Western Placer County Habitat Conservation Plan Programmatic General Permit. The original Notice of Applicability (NOA) was issued on 4 December 2024. The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original NOA is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original NOA.

**AMENDMENT:**

Beazer Homes Holdings is requesting to add a staging area to the Project footprint. The staging area will not result in additional impacts to waters of the state. Beazer Homes Holdings is also requesting to correct a clerical error that was listed in the Compensatory Mitigation Requirement in the NOA.

The Certification is amended to include the staging area, and to correct the Compensatory Mitigation requirement as shown below:

**COMPENSATORY MITIGATION**

To mitigate for the loss of 0.02 acre of seasonal wetland swale and for the indirect impacts to 0.15 acre of seasonal wetland swale, the Applicant shall purchase a minimum of 0.26 seasonal wetland credits from the Western Placer County In-Lieu Fee Program for the impacted watershed prior to commencing construction. The Applicant shall provide evidence of purchase of In-Lieu Fee

Program credits to the Central Valley Water Board prior to commencing construction. At a minimum, compensatory mitigation must achieve a ratio of 1.5:1 for permanent impacts. Compensatory mitigation must comply with the effective policy, which ensures no overall net loss of wetlands for impacts to waters of the state, at the time of Certification.

**APPLICATION FEE RECEIVED:**

No fee was required for this amendment. Total fees of \$2,985.00 for the original Certification were received on 3 October 2024. The fee amount was determined as required by California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 3383(b)(3) and 2200(a)(3), as was calculated as category E - Low Impact Discharges (fee code 87) with the dredge and fill fee calculator.
