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**NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY; GENERAL SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY  
CERTIFICATION ORDER REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO,  
MILLER REGIONAL PARK MARINA BOAT LAUNCH PROJECT  
(WDID#5A34CR00924), SACRAMENTO COUNTY**

On 24 March 2025, the City of Sacramento (Applicant) filed a notification requesting coverage under the 25 February 2022 State Water Resources Control Board Clean Water Act Section 401 General Water Quality Certification and Order of the United States Army Corps of Engineers 2021 Nationwide Permits (General Certification Order) for the Miller Regional Park Marina Boat Launch Project (Project). After review of the notification and the supplemental material submitted by the Applicant, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) has determined that the Project qualifies for enrollment under this General Certification Order. The proposed activity will take place within less than 0.021 acre of waters of the United States.

The Central Valley Water Board is certifying this Project under United States Army Corps of Engineers Nationwide Permit #3a (Maintenance Activities), subject to the conditions and the notification requirements described in the Nationwide Permit ("Special Conditions"). This Notice of Applicability is being issued under the General Certification Order pursuant to Section 3838 of the California Code of Regulations.

The Project must proceed in accordance with the requirements contained in this Notice of Applicability and General Certification Order. The Project is described in the notification form requesting coverage under the General Certification Order, dated 24 March 2025, and supplementary information (Application Package). Coverage under the General Certification Order is no longer valid if the Project (as described) is modified.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**

The 0.7-acre Miller Regional Park Marina Boat Launch Project (Project) consists of the replacement of Rock Slope Protection (RSP) along the sides of the boat launch as a 10-year fix for erosion control.

In addition, the Project will include the repair of the cracks and missing concrete at the boat launch (a 60-by-90-foot boat ramp), replacement of floating dock cables and anchors, repair of 2 floating dock floats (each dock has 4, 8-by-20-foot sections), and installation of RSP alongside the boat launch. The RSP will provide minor slope stabilization to the launch ramp.

Improvements to the boat launch are also designed in compliance with the 2021 Layout and Design Guidelines for Boat launching Facilities. The concrete used for repair will be Type II cement. The concrete will have a 5% air entrainment, 5,000 PSI compressive strength at 28 days, water cement ratio of 0.40, 3- to 4-inch slump, and a 0.75 maximum aggregate. The slope of the repaired boat launch shall remain between a 0.12 and 0.15 percent slope. The Project will temporarily impact 0.021 acre of waters of the United States.

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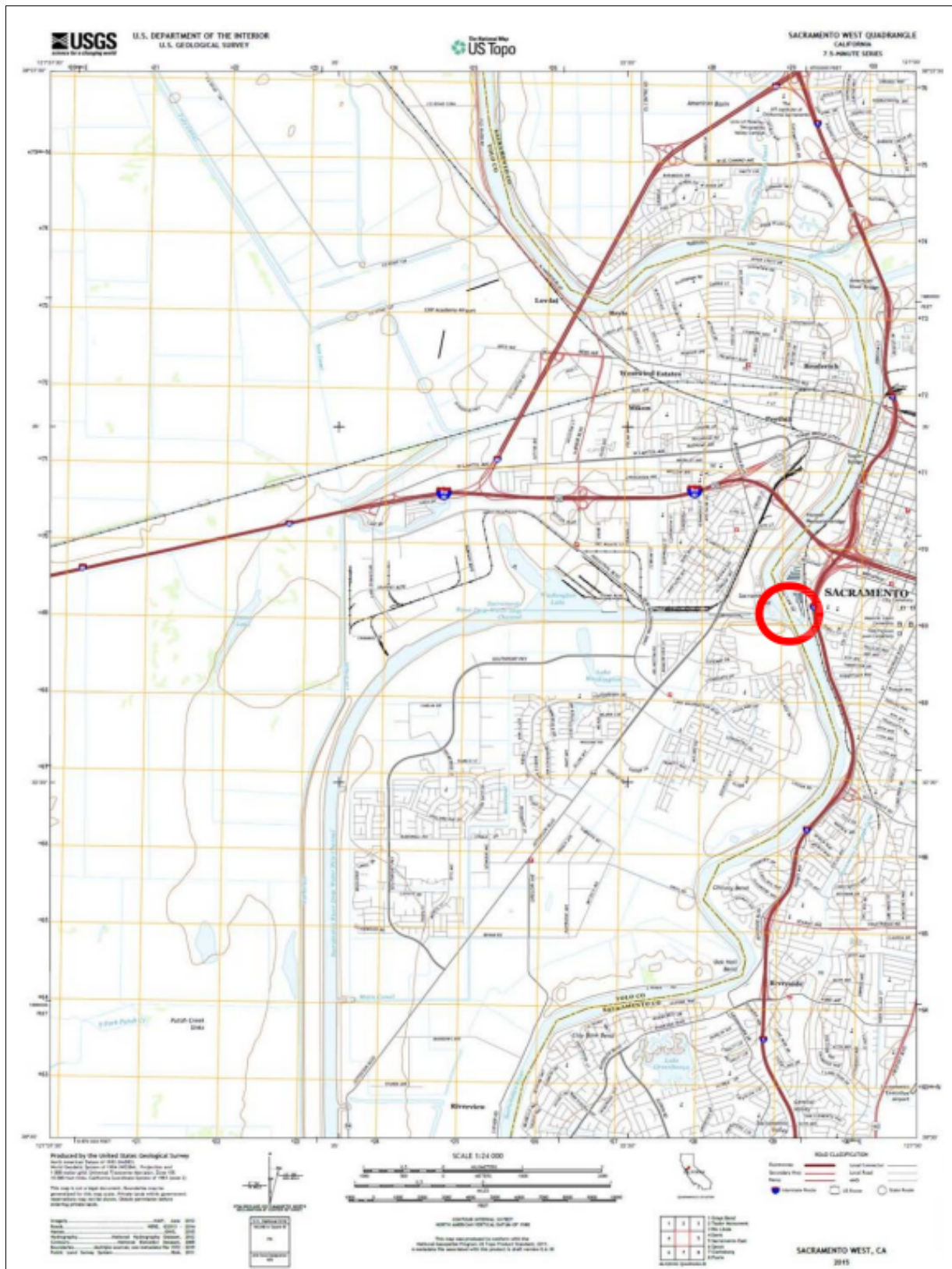


Figure 1 Site Location Map
