ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION AND ORDER FOR CITY OF REDDING, OREGON STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (WDID NO. 5A45CR00613A1), SHASTA COUNTY

This Order responds to the 11 February 2026 request for an amendment of the Oregon Street Improvements Project Section 401 Water Quality Certification and Order (WDID No. 5A45CR00613). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 15 February 2022. The requested amendment is hereby approved, and the original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

City of Redding is requesting an amendment to the Section 401 Water Quality Certification and Order to change the required compensatory mitigation from the purchase of 0.088 acre of constructed channel creation credits and 0.032 acre of seasonal wetland creation credits from Stillwater Plains Mitigation Bank to the purchase of 0.12 Aquatic Resource Credit in the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation's Sacramento District California In-Lieu Fee Program in the Northeast Sacramento River Service Area based on current credit availability. The request has been approved and Section XIV.K.2; and Attachment B, Tables 4 and 5 have been updated, as shown below.

XIV.K Compensatory Mitigation for Permanent impacts:

2. Total Required Compensatory Mitigation

- a. The Permittee is required to provide compensatory mitigation for the authorized impact to 0.088 acre of stream channel and 0.032 acre of wetland by purchasing 0.12 Aquatic Resource Credit from the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation's Sacramento District California In-Lieu Fee Program in the Northeast Sacramento River Aquatic Resource Service Area.
- b. Total required Project compensatory mitigation information for permanent

physical loss of area is summarized in Table 4. [Establishment (Est.), Re-establishment (Re-est.), Rehabilitation (Reh.), Enhancement (Enh.), Preservation (Pres.), Unknown].
