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ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, MARYSVILLE RAILROAD WIDENING PROJECT (03- 0H160) PROJECT (WDID#5A58CR00202A2), YUBA COUNTY

This Order responds to the 30 March 2026 request for an amendment of the Marysville Railroad Widening Project (03-0H160) (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5A58CR00202). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 7 August 2024. The Certification was amended on 16 July 2025 (WDID#5A58CR00202A1). The requested second amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

Caltrans is requesting an amendment to include additional impacts to wetland habitat not identified in the original Certification. The previously reported total impacts were 0.8543 acre (0.3904 acre of permanent and 0.4639 acre of temporary impacts). The updated figure for total impacts is 0.9706 acre (0.3904 acres of permanent impacts and 0.5802 acres of temporary impacts).
