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ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; CITY OF JACKSON, PITT STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT (WDID#5B03CR00076A1), AMADOR COUNTY

This Order responds to the 20 April 2026 request for an amendment of the Pitt Street Bridge Replacement Project (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5B03CR00076). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 4 February 2016.

AMENDMENT:

The City of Jackson is requesting time extension through 15 March 2031. A reverification was authorized by the United States Army Corps of Engineers on 28 April 2026.

The City of Jackson has provided documentation from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (SPK-2016-00045) authorizing in-water construction activities to continue until 15 March 2031 when the existing Nationwide Permits are scheduled to be modified, reissued, or revoked.

Additionally, the City of Jackson is requesting a modification to the authorized project scope. The Project Information Sheet itemizes specific Project activities. Activity 1 is being expanded to include removing and replacing an additional two 6-inch sewer mains from within Jackson Creek. Activities will be done while the work area is dewatered and no water is present in the work area.

The Certification is amended on page 11 as shown below:

1. The existing 10-inch sewer line buried in the creek channel. A backhoe will be used to remove and replace the sewer line. Excavated material will be backfilled over the new sewer line and any excess soil will be removed from the BSA.

Rip-rap will be installed along the eastern side of Jackson Creek adjacent to SR 88 to provide stabilization of the creek bank. Prior to the removal and replacement activities, the channel segment will be dewatered with the use of temporary coffer dams and a diversion pipe that will carry flows (via gravity) from immediately above the sewer removal/replacement segment to a point immediately downstream of this location.

Two existing 6-inch sewer mains will be removed within the Jackson Creek limits. The first 6-inch sewer main connects from Water Street and the second 6-inch sewer main connects to SR-88. Once removed, both sewer mains will be replaced adjacent to their existing locations. A backhoe will be used to remove and replace the sewer line. Excavated material will be backfilled over the new sewer line and any excess soil would be removed.

APPLICATION FEE RECEIVED:

No fee was required for this amendment. Total fees of \$600.00 for the original Certification were received on 11 January 2016. The fee amount was determined as required by California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 3383(b)(3) and 2200(a)(3), as was calculated as category A - Fill & Excavation Discharges (fee code 84) with the dredge and fill fee calculator.

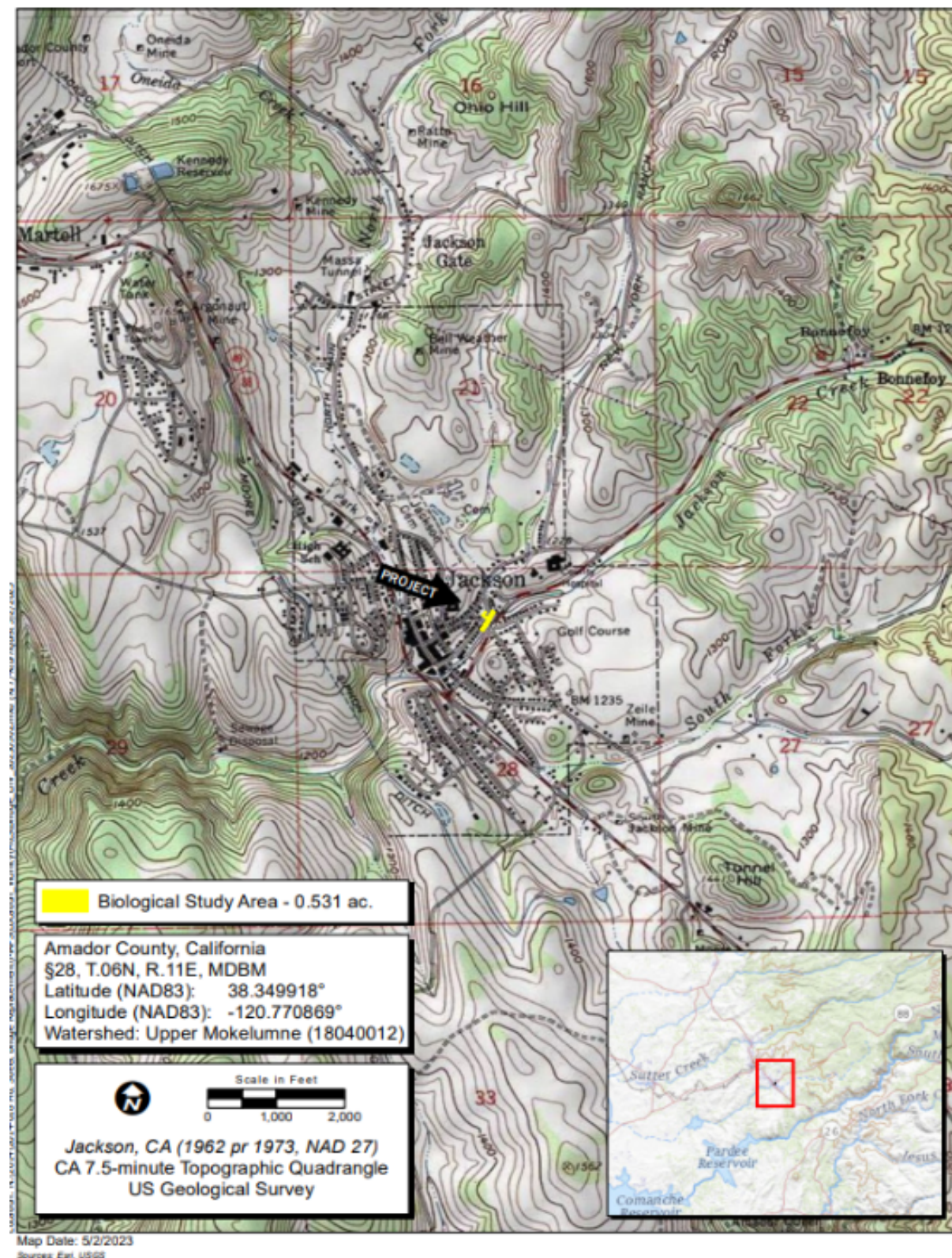


Figure 1. Project Location and Vicinity

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Figure 1 Site Location Map
