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**ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY
CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT
OF TRANSPORTATION (CALTRANS), EA-1: 10-1E850 AMADOR COUNTY STATE
ROUTE/124/ POST MILE 0.32 CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT
(WDID#5B03CR00103A1), AMADOR COUNTY**

This Order responds to the 28 April 2026 request for an amendment of the EA-1: 10-1E850 Amador County State Route/124/Post Mile 0.32 Culvert Replacement Project (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5B03CR00103). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 22 December 2025. The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

The California Department of Transportation has requested an amendment to reflect a change in scope of the project. The culvert will now be replaced by a pre-cast reinforced concrete double-barrel box culvert and the wing walls will be cast-in-place concrete.

The first paragraph of Page 2 of the Certification has been amended as shown below:

Project activities include the removal of the 48-inch-diameter, 46.52-foot-long, double barrel corrugated steel pipe culvert via open trenching, and installation of a new 4-foot by 4-foot modified reinforced pre-cast concrete double-barrel box culvert fabricated off-site and installed as a pre-cast unit. Wingwalls will also be removed and replaced at the inlet and outlet as a cast-in-place unit.

APPLICATION FEE RECEIVED:

No fee was required for this amendment. Total fees of \$4,212.00 for the original Certification were received on 18 November 2025. The fee amount was determined as required by California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 3383(b)(3) and 2200(a)(3),

as was calculated as category E - Low Impact Discharges (fee code 87) with the dredge and fill fee calculator.
